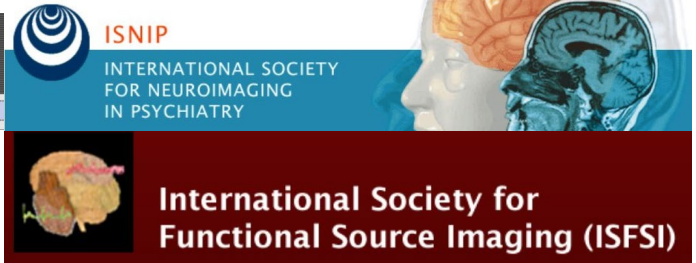
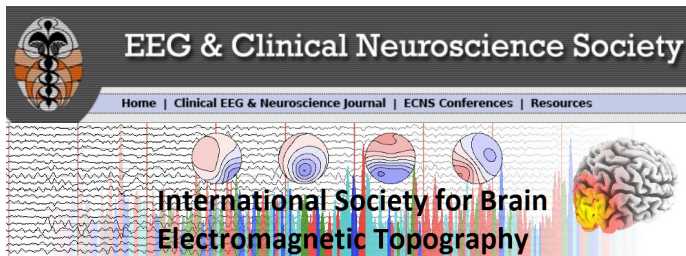


# 2020 Joint Meeting - Save the Date!
